

Emphysema

Possible Causes and Contributing Factors:

- Environmental sensitivity
- Lung destruction due to overuse of tobacco
- With emphysema the alpha 1 anti-trypsin factor will be reduced. This indicates that proteolytic enzymes containing trypsin should not be used. NOTE: With asthma, the alpha 1 anti-trypsin factor will generally not be reduced; therefore, the alpha 1 anti-trypsin factor is an excellent way to differentiate emphysema from asthma
- Adrenal hypo-function
- Increased red blood count, hemoglobin and/or hematocrit

Suggested Dietary Changes:

- Eliminate all dairy
- 8 full glasses of pure water daily
