Neuropathy is damage to a single nerve or nerve group, which results in loss of movement, sensation, or other function of that nerve.

Neuropathy may involve any part of the body. Some of the common forms of Neuropathy include:

- Axillary nerve dysfunction
- Common peroneal nerve dysfunction
- Carpal tunnel syndrome
- Cranial neuropathy III; compression type
- Cranial neuropathy III; diabetic type
- Cranial neuropathy VI
- Cranial neuropathy VII
- Femoral nerve dysfunction
- Radial nerve dysfunction
- Sciatic nerve dysfunction
- Ulnar nerve dysfunction

Symptoms:

- Symptoms depend on the specific nerve affected, and may include:
- Loss of sensation
- Paralysis
- Tingling, burning, pain, abnormal sensations
- Weakness
